All applicants for ISA Mark Layer appointments shall comply with the General and Additional qualifications for Individual Disciplines as set out in the regulations, summarised below, in the last 4 years.

Local Mark Layer (LML): (Qualified to mark lay at small local regattas and club racing)

Pre-Requisites: Have been regularly involved as a Mark Layer at local club or inter club races or small local regattas and have attended the ISA Level Local Mark Layer Course. Completed NPB course.

Regional Mark Layer (RML): (Qualified to mark lay at large multi-fleet regattas and regional regattas)

Pre-Requisites: Have acted as a Local Mark Layer (under the supervision of a Regional or National Mark Layer) for not less than four regional events in at least 2 different venues. Have attended the ISA Regional Mark Layer Course and attained a test score of at least 70%.

National Mark Layer (NML): (Qualified to mark lay at any major national regatta)

Pre-Requisites: Have served as a Regional Mark Layer (under the supervision of a NML) for not less than 4 major events (minimum of 2 of these away from home waters) and have attended the ISA National Mark Layer Course and attained a test score of at least 70%. Recommendations from two National or International Race Officers or National Mark Layers. Have completed a safety boat course successfully.

Consideration will be given to event reports and reports from supervising Mark Layers. All grades must hold a 'Restricted Certificate of Competency in Radiotelephony (VHF Only)' as a minimum.

The ISA Race Officials Policy Group (ROPG) will determine the grade of appointment. Appointments are valid for four years, except for candidates over 70 years when appointments are for 2 years, and may be reviewed and updated annually subject to an ISA Race Official Event Report being completed on the ISA Passport.

N.B. Please attach copies of any relevant certificates or references which you wish to be considered and include additional sheets as required. Please also reference your ISA Passport if this has been completed instead of the logs below.
