All applicants for ISA National Race Official appointments shall comply with the General and Additional qualifications for Individual Disciplines as set out in the regulations, summarised below, in the last 4 years.

National Race Officer (NRO): (Qualified to run any major national event)

Pre-Requisites: Have served as a Race Officer (under the supervision of a NRO) for not less than 4 national events and have attended the ISA Level Two Race Officer Training Course and attained a test score of at least 85%. (Age for first appointment as NRO: over 18 and under 70)

Regional Race Officer (RRO): (Qualified to run large multi-fleet events and regional events)

Pre-Requisites: Have acted as a Race Officer (under the supervision of a National Race Officer) for not less than one major national event or 3 regional events and have attended the ISA Level 2 Race Officer Training Course and attained a test score of at least 70%.

Local Race Officer (LRO): (Qualified to run club racing, small local events)

Pre-Requisites: Have been regularly involved as a Race Officer at local club or inter club races or small local regattas and have attended the ISA Level 1 Race Officer Training Course.

Consideration will be given to event reports and reports from supervising race officials. All grades must hold a 'Restricted Certificate of Competency in Radiotelephony (VHF Only)' as a minimum.

The ISA Race Officials Policy Group (ROPG) will determine the grade of appointment. Appointments are valid for four years, except for candidates over 70 years when appointments are for 2 years, and may be reviewed and updated annually subject to an ISA Race Official Review using your ISA Passport Logbook.
